WELCA Quilting / Prayer Shawl Report - May/June 2019

The **Prayer Shawl ladies** usually meet the first Tuesday morning of the month in the nursery, however during the summer they have not been meeting. They have distributed 5 prayer shawls / blankets in May and June to bring comfort to folks in our church and community that have special prayer concerns.

The **Tuesday Stitchers** meet Tuesday afternoons in the church basement to work on various projects.

Some of the tied fleece blankets have been made to use in lieu of a prayer blanket for those who might need that type of comfort. One tied fleece blanket along with machine quilted quilt were donated for the WELCA Ice Cream Social raffle.

The Tuesday Stitchers have been busy making bags, baby blankets, baby hats, and lap blankets. During May and June, the following agencies benefited from these efforts:

- Avera NICU, 28 baby hats, 5 Baby Afghans, 18 Baby Blankets
- Alpha Center, 14 Baby Blankets
- Ronald McDonald House, 6 Bags, 9 Baby Blankets
- Palisade Manor in Garretson, 13 Tied Blankets, 20 Lap Blankets

The **Quilters** continue to meet on Thursday mornings in the church basement to prepare quilts for Lutheran World Relief and various local charities. Many of the quilts are on display in the Martin Luther Room.



Two quilts were selected and submitted to be sold at the Shetek Quilt Auction on June 22. Some of the quilters attended the auction and watched the quilts sell bringing \$170 for the Shetek Ministries.

Many of the quilters have enjoyed outings to visit quilt shops as a group. In late April we went to Hawarden IA, in May we went to Worthington, and in June we went to Dell Rapids where we also visited the Dell Rapids Lutheran WELCA and enjoyed a wonderful quilt display/discussion and luncheon. We have invited the Dell Rapids ladies to join us on September 5 for quilting and lunch.

Making quilts, prayer shawls, lap blankets and baby blankets will continue to be ongoing missions of WELCA. The following are some ways in which you can help support these missions:
