What is Lent?

Lent is a season of the year that is 40 days leading up to Easter. It begins with Ash Wednesday, the reminder of our mortality and then focuses on the journey to Jesus' death and Resurrection. You'll notice that worship is simplified and that we put away the word "alleluia" for the season. During Lent, we will highlight the stories from the Gospel of Luke that lift up God's persistent mercy in the face of obstacles in Sunday morning worship. We will have a completely different worship and message on Wednesday nights, as we focus on the Small Catechism.

Some Christians take the time of Lent as a time of re-centering in faith. Some people do that by "giving something up". Personally, my practice has been to take on a Spiritual practice- a devotion or a prayer.

This year, we will provide resources for "CandleTime" that might be a good option for Lenten practice. I also like the app D365 for personal devotions. Author, Kate Bowler, also provides a free Lenten devotional on her website: katebowler.com/lent.

I encourage you to consider how you might grow in faith this Lent!

During the season of Lent, we invite you to deepen into our Lutheran roots on Wednesday Nights!!

We hear these words every week during Lent in our Gospel Acclamation. These words come to us from the book of Joel in the Old Testament. What a true statement about our God. He is most certainly gracious, merciful, slow to anger, and abounding in love. All are qualities we should aspire to have, too!

March brings the beginning of Lent with Ash Wednesday on March 5. Let us enter a time of "returning" to the Lord. Typically, people give something up for Lent as a minor sacrifice to help realize how incredibly big Jesus' sacrifice on the cross was. What if this year, instead of only giving something up, we add something. What if we add something to our days of Lent to deepen our faith life? Adding something will look different for everyone! This can be something as simple as taking even a minute or two to pray every day. Or maybe it could be something as simple as returning to Worship each week of Lent. Whatever it is, no one has ever regretted taking another step in their faith life!

Ash Wednesday Worship is March 5 at 6:00 PM. The Bell Choir and Choir will provide the music! The rest of the Wednesdays in Lent will have a different theme than our Sunday services. This year, the Pastors will be focusing on Luther's Catechism, and it will be a neat way to learn more about what Lutherans believe! So, if you typically come only on Sundays, you are encouraged to come Wednesdays, as well!

We have lots of opportunities for you to get more involved with our Bell Choir, Brass Ensemble, Choir, and Praise Band! Joining one of these ensembles is a great way to build new relationships, have fun, and grow in your faith and worship of our Lord! Do you sing or play an instrument? Do you know someone who does? May you all find a deeper connection with God and His great mercy, grace, and love this Lenten Season.


